## Invitation for Bids

<b>Date:</b>	Tuesday, 4 <sup>th</sup> March 2021

1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh is requesting for financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project (DESWSP). Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above by Dhaka WASA. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (DWASA), represented by the Project Director, Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project, (the Employer) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the "Design and Construction of Feeder Lines inside Dhaka under DESWSP" ("the Facilities"). Major items of the proposed facilities include Survey, Design, Pressure Tests, Pre-commissioning, Commissioning. It includes supplying and laying of 355 – 800 OD HDPE pipes (40 km) and DN 800 DI pipes (3.2 km) water distribution lines using Open Trench and an option for the use of Trenchless technologies, key Plant supplies of regular and special valves, and bulk-water meters are also part of the facility. Environmental and Social management aspects also form a component of the project. The completion period is 30 months (912 days).
3. Open competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's 'Single Stage: Two-Envelop' procedure in compliance to the 'User's Guide to Procurement of Plant (Design, Supply and Installation) of June 2018 and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
  - **Average Annual Turnover:** The minimum annual average turnover shall be USD 25 (Twenty-five) million in last three years.
  - **Sufficient Availability of Financial Resources:** The Bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources defined in FIN - 3, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments defined in FIN - 4, meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of **USD 4.2 million**.
  - **Contracts of Similar Size and Nature:**
    - Participation as a contractor, Joint Venture partner, or Subcontractor, in at least two Reference Contracts that have been successfully or substantially completed within the last 10 years and that are similar to the proposed contract, where the value of the Bidder's participation under each contract exceeds \$ 25 million The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on:
      - 1. nature of the works: civil works in water and wastewater projects.
    - Participation in at least three Reference Contracts that have been successfully or substantially completed within the last 10 years prior to the bid submission date, where scope of works under each contract includes management and supervision of design, procurement and supply to site, installation, testing, disinfection, pre-commissioning and commissioning of more than 20 km of pipeline for potable water supply in roads. Out of the three contracts one shall have used at least 1km of ductile iron pipe of minimum diameter DN600 and at least one contract shall have used minimum 10km of HDPE pipe of outside diameter greater than 450mm.



5. To purchase the Bidding Documents in English, eligible Bidders should:
    - Visit the office of Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project (DESWSP) at the address above and pay a non-refundable fee of BDT 20,000 or USD 250 by Demand Draft or Pay Order in favor of the Executing Agency Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (DWASA), Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project; OR
    - Contact the office of DESWSP at the address above and request for delivery by courier for an additional amount of BDT 5,000 for delivery within Bangladesh, or USD 50 for delivery outside Bangladesh. The method of payment will be by Demand Draft or Pay Order in favor of the Executing Agency Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (DWASA), Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project. Upon receipt of payment, the document will be sent by courier to the Bidders or their representatives. No liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery by DWASA.
  6. The Employer will arrange a site visit and pre-bid meeting that would be held on Sunday, 28 March 2021 from 10:00hr to 13:00hr (local time) and Tuesday, 30 March 2021 at 15:00hr (local time) at the DWASA Conference Room 'Sitalakhya' respectively. The intended mode of participation for pre-bid meeting and site visit shall be in person wherein specific protections in the form of social distancing shall be practiced; bidders will be permitted to attend the pre-bid meeting over online video-conferencing such as Zoom, Microsoft Teams. Attendance at the pre-bid meeting is highly encouraged for the bidders and their specialist subcontractors for the trenchless technology work. If requested, the Employer will issue a letter of invitation to support a visa application on behalf of the bidder up to one week before the pre-bid meeting date. To assist in the planning for the meeting, it is requested that the bidders within seven days after purchasing the document advise the undersigned on the number of people that will be attending. Bidders are restricted to a maximum of 2 representatives for each meeting.
  7. Deliver your bid:
    - to the address as given above.
    - on or before the deadline: As mentioned above or as amended.
    - together with a Bid Security/Bid-Securing Declaration as described in the Bidding Document.
    - Electronic submission of Bids is not permitted.
- Technical Bids will be opened 15 minutes after the deadline for bid submission in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend, whereas the Financial Bids shall remain sealed and unopened and shall be placed locked. The Financial Bids of qualified Bidders whose Technical Bids are evaluated as substantially responsive to the bidding documents shall be opened, whereas, the Financial Bids of those Bidders whose Technical Bids are evaluated as substantially nonresponsive and/or not qualified shall be returned unopened after the contract is awarded.
9. The Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of Bids.
  10. When comparing Bids, Domestic preference shall not apply.
